Contest Rules

1. Competition held under Prairie Pipe Band Association of Manitoba Inc. rules.
2. All entries must be postmarked by 21 May, 2010 or a late fee of \$25 will be charged for solos, \$50 for bands. Fees and nominal rolls must accompany all entries. Grade II bands must include a list of tunes for both MSR sets. Improper or incomplete entries will be returned. Organizers will not be responsible for late or misdirected mail.
3. Competitor numbers will be mailed prior to the competition upon receipt of correct entry fees and a stamped self-addressed envelope (9x4).
4. For solo events, the first to enter will be the last to play. Order of play for bands will be drawn prior to the contest.
5. Solo competitors must be registered with their home association. Solo competitors residing within the PPBAM boundaries must possess a PPBAM 2010 Grading Card to be presented upon request. Solo competitors must enter the grade of their home association and may play up. PPBAM rules apply.
6. Field entries will be accepted, time permitting.
7. Any competitor/band not ready to perform at their scheduled time, may be disqualified.
8. Bands must be registered with their home association. An up-to-date band roster must accompany their entry.
9. Bands must enter the grade of their home association and may **not** play up. PPBAM rules apply.
10. All bands must appear in massed bands to be eligible to receive prize money.
11. Decisions by judges on performances are final.
12. The organizers reserve the right to reject any entry, to add or remove events from the schedule, and to make other changes.
13. Awards:
 - Up to 7 competitors in any one class – 3 awards
 - 8 competitors in any one class – 4 awards
 - 10 competitors in any one class – 5 awards
 - 12 competitors or more – 6 awards

Special Event Rules:

10th Anniversary Concert Event - Bands are invited to construct a unique medley of 7 to 10 minutes. This event can be performed in circle formation, concert formation, or any other formation as long as the band remains in the general performance area. Bands may incorporate bagpipes, drums, as well as other instruments, but all instruments must be played by registered band members. Tunes played should be tunes other than those submitted for the other band events, they can include non-traditional tunes/songs, but the overall performance should include some Scottish and/or Celtic music. Bands will be judged on musicality and originality.

Note: As a commitment to our advertisers, each competitor will receive a program included in their registration costs.

All Provincial Regulations under the Parklands Act and the Liquor Control Act must be adhered to. This means NO liquor in the park. Breach of this rule will result in disqualification.
